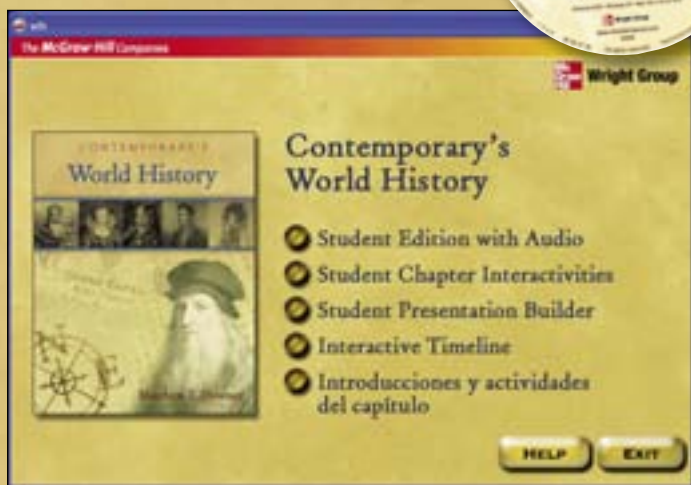
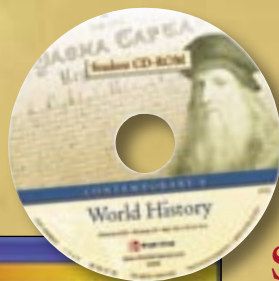
World History incorporates the National Council for the Social Studies (NCSS) high school thematic strands. The book includes events beginning with pre-history and continuing through the modern era.

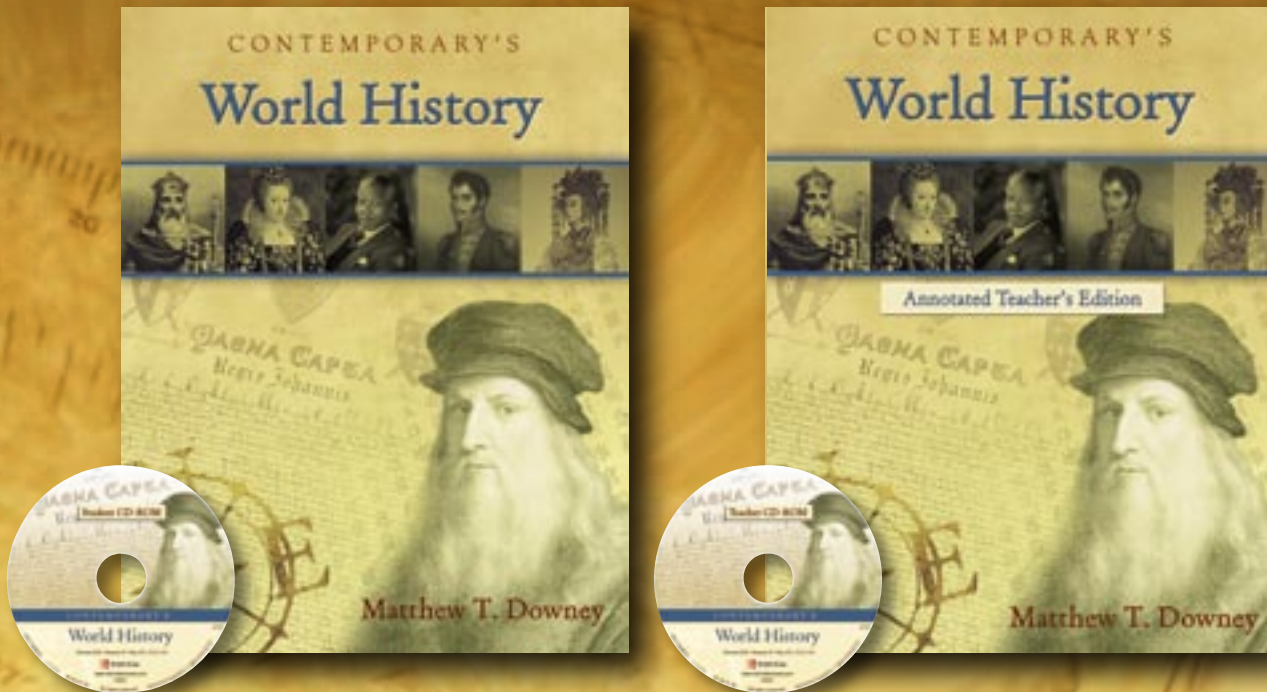
