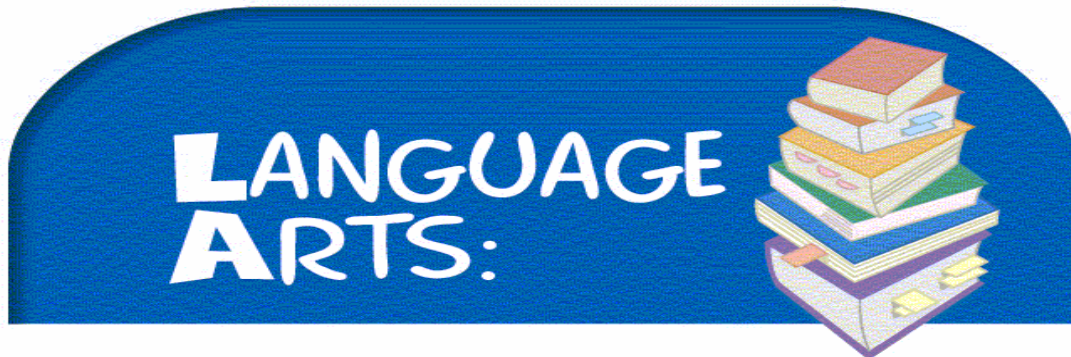


## Glencoe Curriculum Portfolio Activities—Unit 5



### Language Arts 1

#### Create a Web page.

What kinds of Web sites do you like to visit? Is there a particular topic you usually research or look for on the Web? Think about the kind of information you would like to find on a Web site. Then read “The Story Behind the Diary,” an article from a Web site about Anne Frank. This article gives some background information about Anne and how her diary was eventually published.
