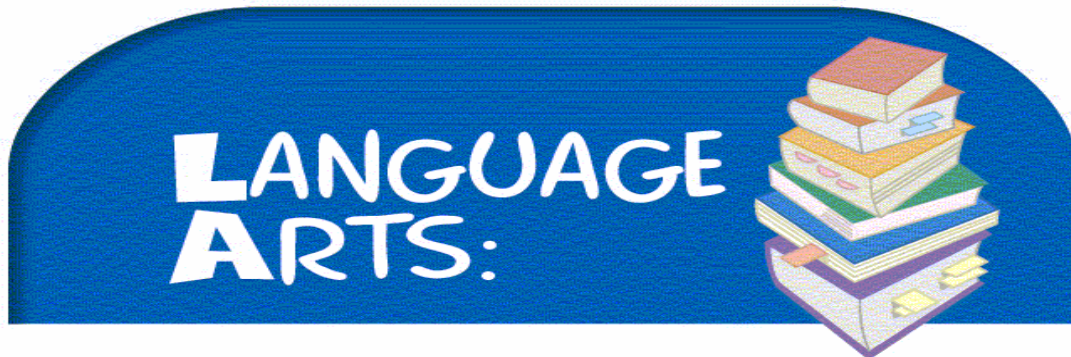


Glencoe Curriculum Portfolio Activities—Unit 7

Create a spreadsheet about baseball.

“Strike three! You’re out!” Have you ever heard that called out? Maybe you have been the batter who struck out. Major league baseball players strike out often. You can read about a ball player at bat in “Casey at the Bat” in your text *Glencoe Literature: The Reader’s Choice*.

Research on the Internet to find information for a spreadsheet about baseball. Find information about batters such as Babe Ruth, Hank Aaron, and Mark McGuire. Find out how many times they have been at bat, how many times they have struck out, and how many singles, doubles, triples, and homeruns they have hit.

Key the information into a spreadsheet. Proofread the numbers carefully. Create a bar chart with the information.
