Social Studies

Create a newsletter and a Web page.

1. Imagine that you are a Patriot living in Boston during the Revolutionary War period. Create a newsletter that you could send to Patriots living in other colonies telling about the Boston Massacre, the Boston Tea Party, and the Coercive Acts that closed Boston Harbor.
