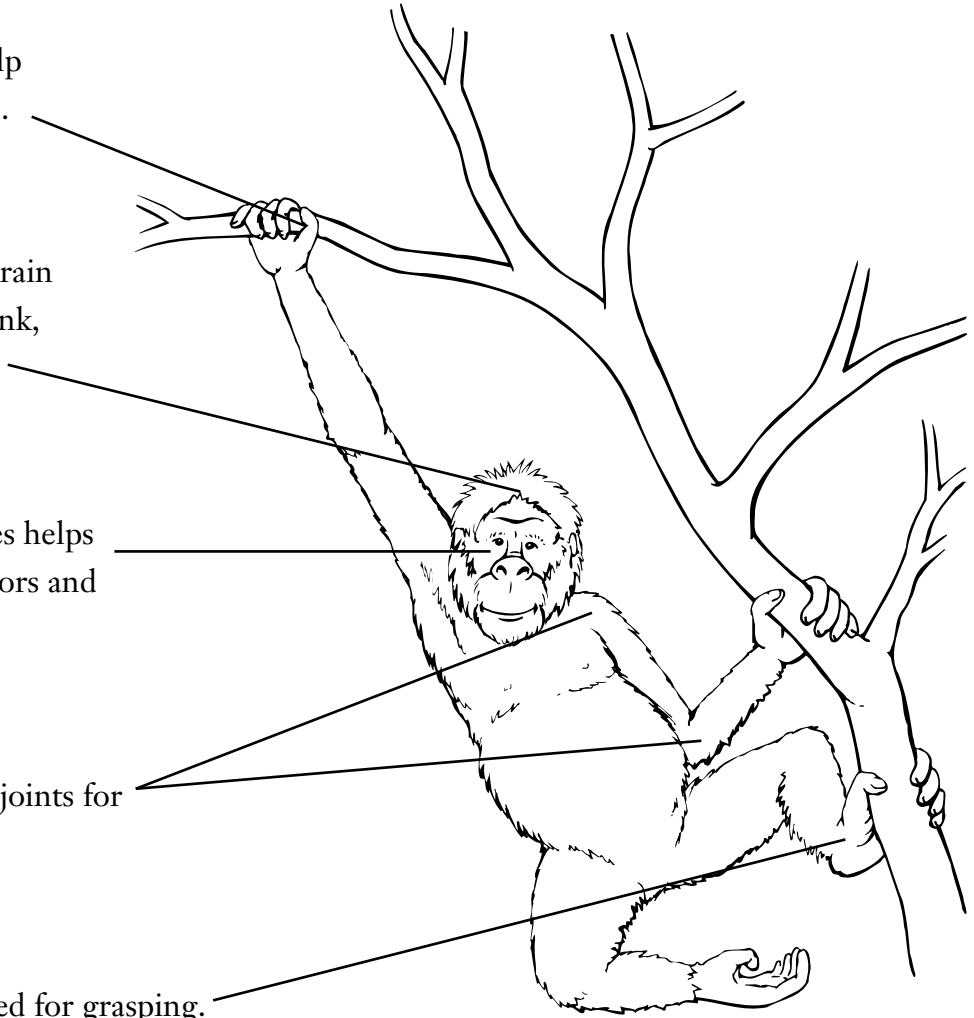
Opposable thumbs help primates grasp objects.
