The Six Kingdoms



- Archaeobacteria**
- one-celled bacteria
 - found only in extreme environments



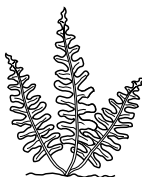
- Eubacteria**
- bacteria with one or more cells
 - found in many places



- Protists**
- can have one or more cells
 - can be plantlike, animal-like, or funguslike



- Fungi**
- can have one or more cells
 - consumers
 - stay in one place



- Plants**
- many-celled life forms
 - use photosynthesis to produce oxygen
 - cannot move on their own



- Animals**
- many-celled consumers
 - can move on their own
 - have complex oxygen systems
