metal spoon
string
scissors
ruler

Procedure

1. Cut a length of string 60 cm long.
2. At the center of the length of string, fasten the spoon by tying a knot.
3. Ask a friend to help. Stand by the kitchen sink with your index fingers in each ear. Ask a friend to hold the string by its ends and tap the spoon against the side of the sink. Listen to the sound of the spoon.
4. Now take the string and spoon back from your friend and wrap the ends of the string two or three times around your index fingers. Then place your fingers in your ears as before and tap the spoon against the same place in the sink. Listen to the sound of the spoon again.
