How to Save and Print (or E-Mail) Your Journal Entries

1. After completing each journal entry, be sure to click the **save entry** button. Your entry will be *temporarily* saved to a main journal page containing all of your journal entries.

Note: You do not have to print or e-mail each entry separately.

2. When you have completed all the assigned journal questions or when you need to leave the interactive Web site, choose the **print journal** button. You will be taken to the main journal entry page where you can review and change any journal entry before printing them all.
3. When you are ready to print, select the **printer-friendly** button. This will take you to a printer-friendly page that can be printed using your browser button or e-mailed using the e-mail option at the bottom of the page.

Note: You cannot make changes to your entries once you go to the printer-friendly page. At this point, the entries are removed from the interactive Web site; however, you will still see them on the printer-friendly page, which you can e-mail or print.

WARNING!!!

You **must print or e-mail** your journal entries **before leaving the interactive Web site**. Once you close the interactive Web site window or visit the printer-friendly page, your entries will be **permanently removed**.
