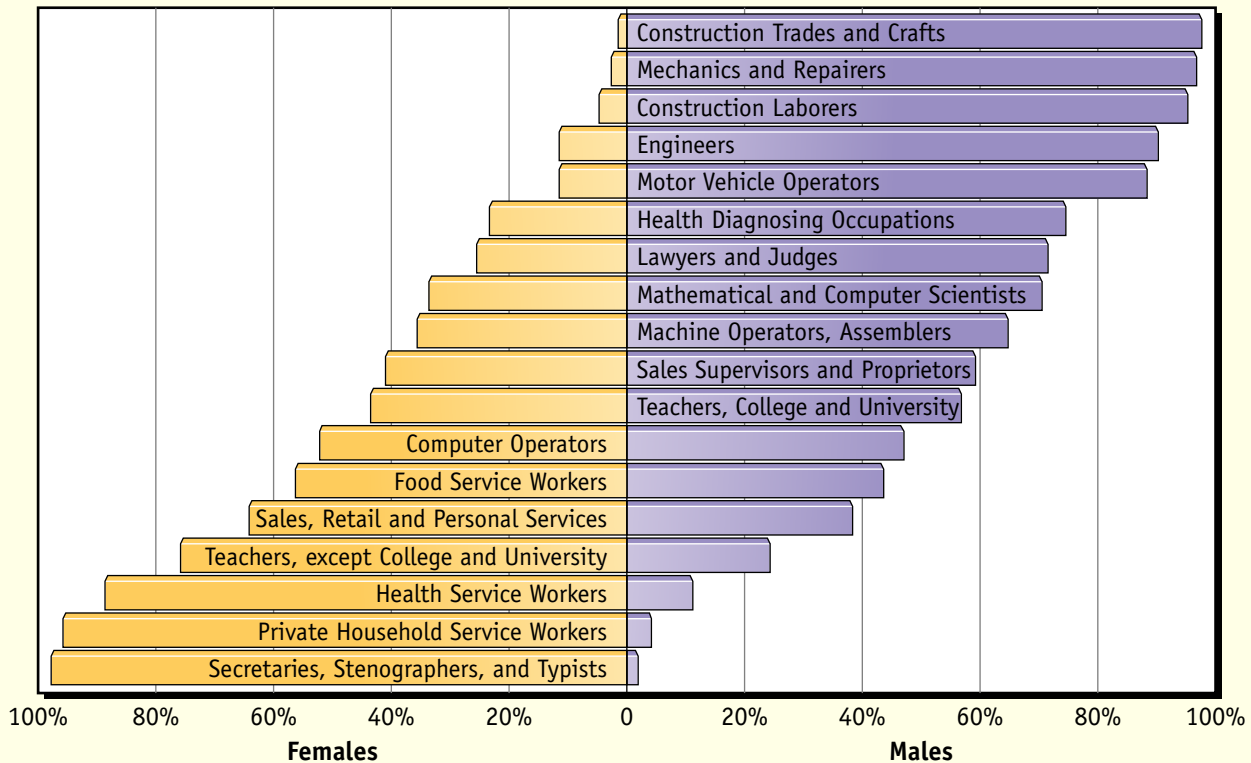


Distribution of Male and Female Jobs by Occupation

Using Graphs One of the reasons for the pay differential between the sexes is that men and women are not evenly distributed among occupations.
