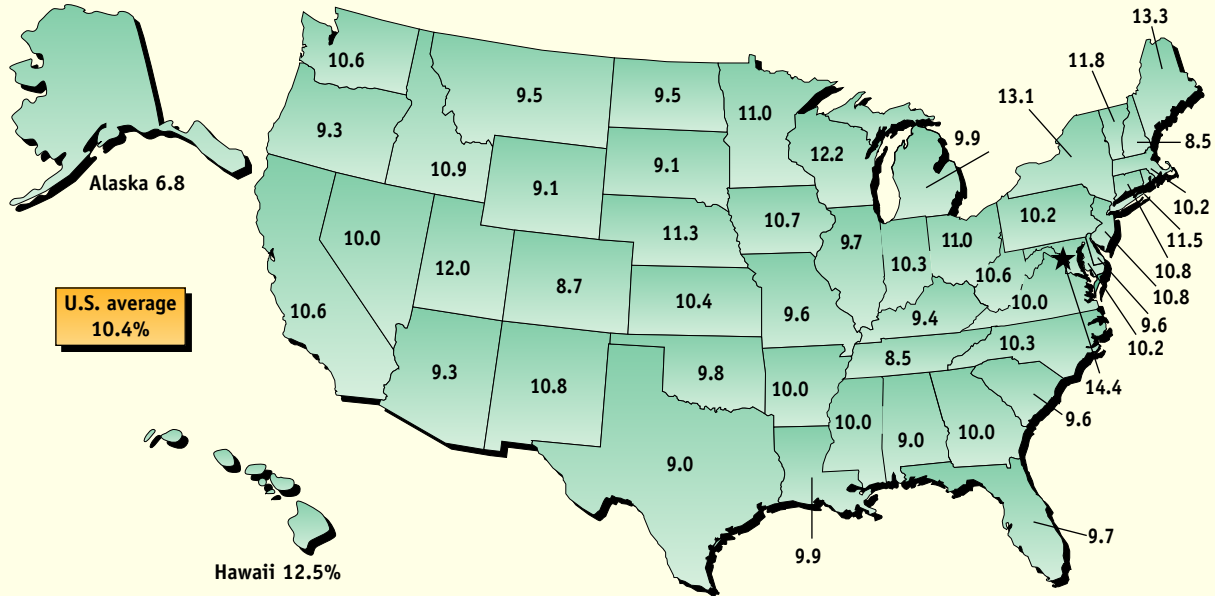


### State and Local Taxes as a Percentage of State Income
