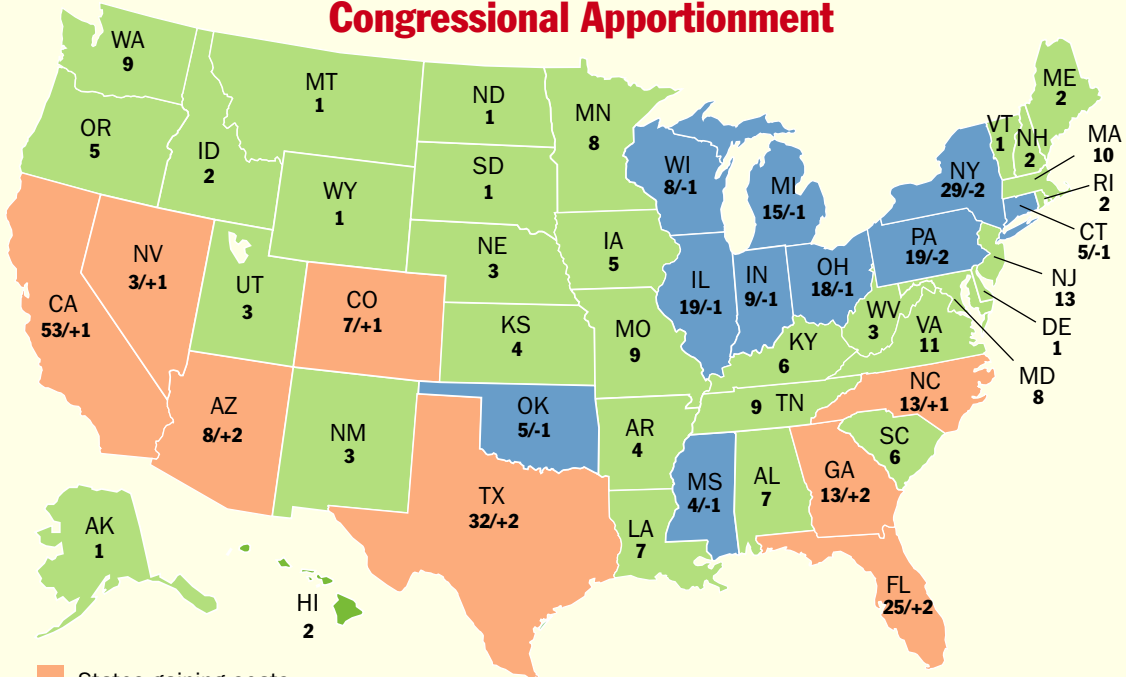




Congressional Apportionment
