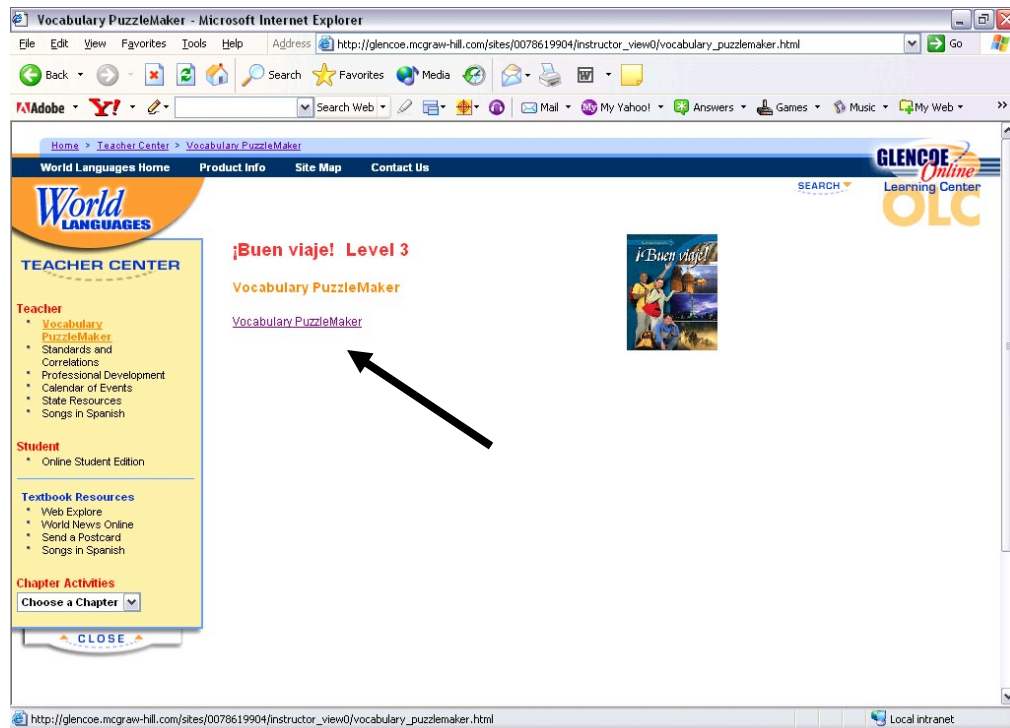


Vocabulary PuzzleMaker Download Instructions

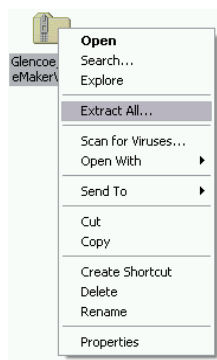
1. Navigate to a Vocabulary PuzzleMaker download page from the Teacher Center.



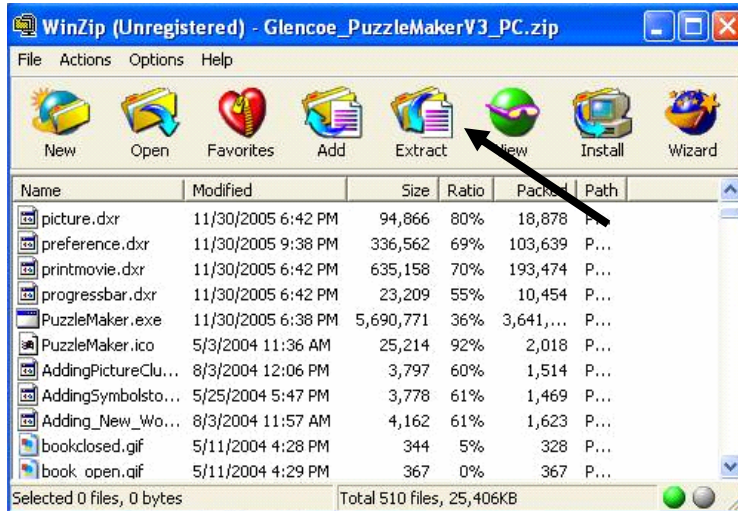
2. Download Glencoe Vocabulary PuzzleMaker using the following instructions. Similar instructions are located on the Vocabulary PuzzleMaker download page.

Download and save the Vocabulary PuzzleMaker file that matches your computer's operating system—Macintosh OS9, Macintosh OSX, or Windows 98 and up. Extract the files to a temporary location on your computer.

- If you are using Windows 2000 or XP, right-click on the file and select "Extract All ..."; follow the extraction wizard screen prompts to extract the files.



- If you are using Windows 98, use WinZip to extract the files. You can download the WinZip Evaluation Version from the Vocabulary PuzzleMaker download page. Double-click the compressed Vocabulary PuzzleMaker file and then click “Extract.”



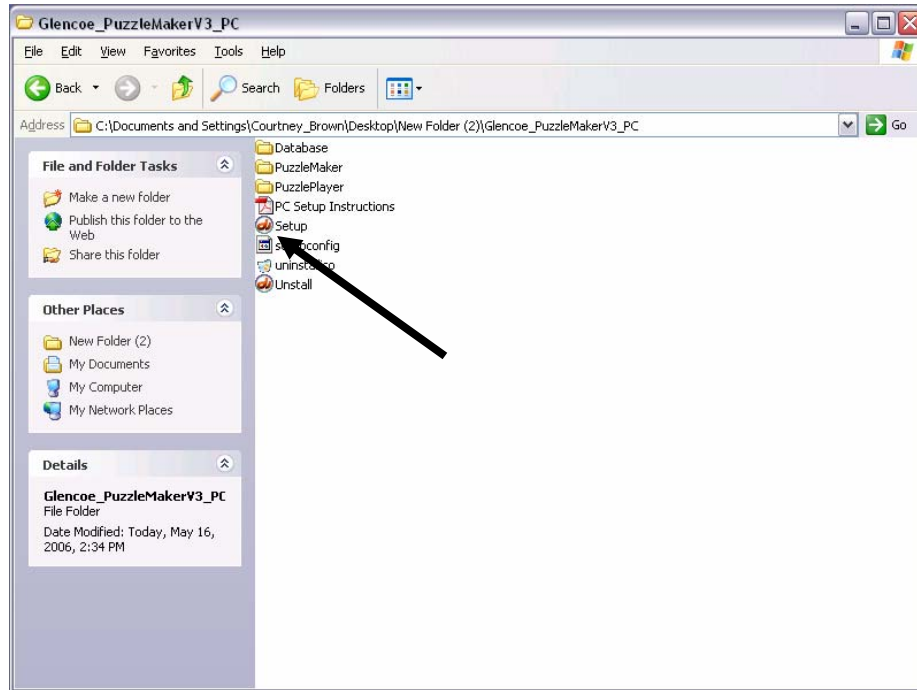
Note: If you are using the WinZip Evaluation Version you must click “Use Evaluation Version” before you can extract the files.

- If you are using a Macintosh, use Stuffit Expander to extract the files. You can download Stuffit Expander from the Vocabulary PuzzleMaker download page. Drag and drop the Vocabulary PuzzleMaker file over your Stuffit Expander program to extract the PuzzleMaker setup files.



Note: If the file fails to download properly and you see unintelligible text in the browser window, click the browser “Back” button to return to the download page. Hold down the “Option” key while clicking on the required link. You will be prompted for the location where the file will be saved on your computer. After downloading the file to the selected location, drag and drop the file over your Stuffit Expander program to extract the PuzzleMaker setup files.

Double-click “Setup” in the newly extracted file and follow the onscreen prompts of the PuzzleMaker Setup Wizard to complete the installation process.



3. Download a Vocabulary PuzzleMaker Database

Click the link of the Vocabulary Database that you would like to download located on the Vocabulary PuzzleMaker Download page. Save the file to your computer and note your selected download location. Next, extract the file(s) to a temporary location on your computer. Then, copy the file(s) to PuzzleMaker’s Database folder. For the following platforms, the paths are as follows:

Glencoe Vocabulary PuzzleMaker 3.0

- Macintosh:
Macintosh HD:Applications:PuzzleMakerV3:database
- Windows:
C:\Program Files\PuzzleMaker Version 3\database

Glencoe Vocabulary PuzzleMaker 3.1

- Macintosh:
Macintosh HD: Applications: PuzzleMaker 3_1:database
- Windows:
C:\Program Files\PuzzleMaker Version 3_1\database

Delete the temporary file(s). Now you are ready to use your new vocabulary database!

4. Creating Puzzles with Your New Database

Launch Vocabulary PuzzleMaker and click “Create a New Puzzle.” Locate the new vocabulary database file you just downloaded and click “Open.” The PuzzleMaker Wizard will launch and you’re ready to create!
